(The 22 May 2015 was the day that the National Management Team approved the final Birthday Gift. You also surprised me on this day with a phone call on your behalf, thanking me for the DVD Birthday Gift I sent in 2012 regarding the Australian Chanting Tour.)

We connected with her by singing the Guru Gita at the same time in the Melbourne Ashram. Siddha Yogi's also offered the Guru Gita in the Manhattan Ashram in the USA. (Others around Australia may have also sang the Guru Gita for the offering.)
